

ASSISTANT FIRE CHIEF - TRAINING

The City of Lebanon is currently accepting applications and résumés' to fill the position of Assistant Fire Chief of Training. The Assistant Fire Chief performs responsible administrative, supervisory, and technical work in any major function of the Fire Department such as operations, training, or technical services. This position also serves as the second-ranking officer in the Fire Department.

Minimum qualifications include an Associate's degree, Bachelor's degree preferred, in Fire Science, Business Administration, or other related field plus six (6) years experience in a full-time paid position with a municipal fire department or fire district with at least four (4) of those years in a supervisory position at the Captain level or higher or 10 (ten) years of experience in a volunteer fire department of similar size, call volume, and operations which demonstrate a high level of supervisory and budgetary responsibilities.
